

Tree, Brush, Yard Waste Removal Guidelines

The Town of Green Level contracts Republic Waste to provide yard and brush pick-up for the Town's residents. Please be timely and organized in preparing your yard and brush waste for pick-up. It makes Republic Waste work safer and quicker.



Tree branches and limbs are to be stacked neatly parallel to the street.



Tree limbs must be cut no longer than 4 feet in length. **DO NOT** place tree limbs under the ground wire on the power pole.



Leaves and yard waste must be placed in garbage bags. Do not rake leaves in ditch.



Brush is defined as leaves, dead plants, flowers, twigs, vines, hay/straw, pine cones/needles, small branches, and weeds, etc. **DO NOT** put brush in miscellaneous trash cans. Republic

Waste will only pick up small amount of brush in garbage bags.



DO NOT put in your brush pile materials such as lumber, demolition debris, rock, concrete, hazardous waste, and household goods. If any of these items are mixed in the brush pile, the entire pile will be left behind until the homeowner removes the unacceptable materials.



Large quantities of brush resulting from the removal of trees, stumps, and land clearing will not be collected. It is the homeowner's or tree service contractor's responsibility to arrange for disposal. Quantities of brush pick up will be limited to one (1) pickup truck load per resident per pickup. Additional pick up fee for this service will be \$25.00 per truck load, paid by the homeowner at the Town Hall. The Town **WILL NOT** pay for this expense. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**



Please do not place brush piles and tree limbs on vacant lots.



Tree limbs and brush must be kept on your lawn on the curbside - **NOT IN THE STREET.**



DO NOT place your brush or tree limbs out several weeks before the schedule pick-up date. Call the Town Hall at (336) 578-3443 to be placed on the pick-up list (by Monday, before the pickup date on Tuesday) no later than 2:00 PM.
