## TIPS TO LOWER YOUR WATER BILL

1. Store cold water in the fridge
2. Take shorter showers
3. Wash clothes in cold water
4. Install a low-flow shower head and low-flow flush kit on your toilet
5. Don't let the water run when shaving or brushing your teeth
6. Run full loads of dishes and laundry
7. Don't hand wash dishes use dishwasher
8. Fix leaks – get a plumber
9. Tighten your water spigots (inside and out)
10. Insulate your water pipes and/or add aerators to your faucets.



## BULK AND YARD WASTE PICKUP

Republic Waste Services will pick up Bulk Items on Tuesday January 7<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> and Yard Waste on Tuesday, January 14<sup>th</sup>. Please call (336) 578-3443 to be put on the list. **REMINDER:** Effective July 1, 2019 leaves and grass clippings can no longer be placed in plastic bags. They must be placed in paper bags or cardboard boxes. You can purchase paper leaf bags at Lowes, Home Depot, Walmart, etc.



## BILLING DATES

Your January 1<sup>st</sup> bill is due on or before **January 15<sup>th</sup>.** **On January 16<sup>th</sup> the \$12 late fee will be applied.** The January bill is for services received and water used from **November 15 - December 15, 2019.** To avoid getting on the **January 27<sup>th</sup> Cutoff List** which adds \$20 to your bill, please make payment by **Sunday, January 26<sup>th</sup>.** Payment methods include the Drop Box, in person at the window or online <https://greenlevelnc.com/> or mail to: Town of Green P.O.
