



## Tree Limbs, Brush, Yard Waste Removal Guidelines

The Town of Green Level contacts Republic Waste to provide yard waste and brush pick-up for the Town's residents. Please be timely and organized in preparing for pick-up. It makes Republic Waste's work safer and quicker.

- ✿ Yard waste/brush pick-up is on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month. **Call the Town Hall to be put on the pick-up list** (At least by Monday before pick-up date on Tuesday, no later than 2:00 PM. (336)578-3443)
- ✿ Please **DO NOT** place your brush/limbs next to the street several weeks before the scheduled pick-up date and do not place brush piles and tree limbs on vacant lots.
- ✿ Three days before the scheduled pick-up, tree branches and brush are to be stacked neatly parallel to the street. Yard Waste will be placed in Standard Containers (**except plastic bags**), heavy duty paper bags, cardboard boxes, or separately at curbside prior to 6:00 a.m on the Service Day.
- ✿ All Yard Trim generated by Residential Property be prepared for collection as follows: All trees and limbs must be cut into lengths no longer than four (4) feet, and no more than four (4) inches in diameter. Limbs must be bundled and tied. Bundles of limbs and trees must be in manageable piles. No bundle can exceed forty (40) pounds in weight.
- ✿ **DO NOT** rake yard waste into the stormwater ditch. Yard waste is defined as leaves, dead plants, flowers, twigs, vines, hay/straw, pine cones, pine needles and weeds. Republic Waste will only pick up yard waste if it is contained in proper containers. **DO NOT** put yard waste into miscellaneous trash cans. **DO NOT** put in your brush pile materials such as lumber, demolition debris, rock, concrete, hazardous waste, and household goods. If any of these items are mixed in the brush pile, the entire pile will be left behind until the homeowner removes the unaccepted materials.
- ✿ Large quantities of brush resulting from the removal of trees, stumps, bushes, and land clearing **WILL NOT** be collected. It is the homeowner's or tree contractor's responsibility to dispose of large quantities. Republic Waste limits brush/limbs pick-up to one (1) pickup truck load per resident per pick-up. Additional pickup truck loads can be called by Republic Waste for \$25 each, paid for by the homeowner at the Town Hall. The Town **WILL NOT** pay for the expense of extra pick-ups. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ✿ **Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the brush/limbs/etc. being picked up by the Towns Public Works staff at the request of the Code Enforcement Officer. The homeowner will be billed up to \$250.00.**
