The Town of Green Level offers three Shelter Facilities. Two of the shelters are dedicated to Montford Point Marines

### Corporal Cleo Florence and Sergeant John Phoenix.

The Montford Point Marines were the first African Americans to enlist in the U.S. Marine Corps after President Franklin Roosevelt issues an Executive Order establishing the Fair Employment Practices Commission in June 1941. The recruits trained at a segregated training camp called Camp Montford Point in Jacksonville, NC from August 26, 1942, until the camp was decommissioned on September 9, 1949.

Cleo Florence and John Phoenix were 2 of the approximately 20,000 that trained at the segregated, snake infested training camp.

John Phoenix of Green Level enlisted into the United States Marine Corps on March 30, 1949. He retired on September 30, 1974, at the rank of Sergeant.

Cleo Florence was drafted into the United States Marine Corps on October 27, 1943, and he was honorably discharged at the rank of Corporal on May 17, 1946.
