Planning Board Vacancy

The Planning Board’s function and duty is to make recommendations for the physical development of the town. The Planning Board makes recommendations for the development of the territory, including the extent of streets, waterways, parks, the general location of public utilities, etc. The Planning Board may from time to time recommend amendments, extensions, or additions to the master plan.

The Town of Green Level is looking for applicants that live within Town of Green Level’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction. The Town of Green Level’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction residents are those that live in Green Level or within the one-mile radius of Green Level.

The Planning Board is a five-member board that meets on the second Tuesday of every other month at 6pm in the Town Hall Building.

Applications can be located on Town of Green Level Website or at the Town Hall Building. Applications should be returned to the Town Clerk in the Town Hall at 2510 Green Level Church Rd. Green Level, NC 27217
