 Brush pick-up days are **January 3rd** and **January 16th**. Please call the Town Hall (336)578-3443 by 2pm the business day **before** the scheduled pick-up day, to be added to the Bulk or Brush list.

Attention BULK

Construction items, electronics, aerosol, tires, logs over 3.ft long and any wooden item with nails will NOT be picked-up.

Bulk is limited to 10 items. *Anything outside of those 10 items are subject to be fined by the Town.*

Residents may call the landfill at (336) 376-8902 for advice on proper disposal.

Please do not place bulk underneath powerlines.

RECYCLE/TRASH

Trash and recycle containers will NOT be picked up if it is overflowing, the lid must be closed. Please pull trashcans back after pick-up. Multiple trashcans should have space between them for pick-up.



Code Enforcement

Please be advised, there has been an increasing number of trash & recycling containers being left at the edge of the driveways. The town will be collecting the trash & recycled containers that are left out on Wednesdays after regular pick-up. Residents are subject to a fine of \$50 for the return of containers. In the mid-1950s Martin Luther King Jr led the movement to end segregation and counter prejudice in the United States through the means of peaceful protest.

Planning Board Vacancy

The Planning Board's function and duty is to make recommendations for the physical development of the town. The Planning Board makes recommendations for the development of the territory, including the extent of streets, waterways, parks, the general location of public utilities, etc. The Planning Board may from time to time recommend amendments, extensions, or additions to the master plan.

The Planning Board is a five-member board that meets on the second Tuesday of every other month at 6pm in the Town Hall Building.
