PARK & RECREATION

The Park and Recreation Department offers Baseball, Softball, Football, and Basketball annually. The lack of consistent participation in Recreation programs here in the Town of Green Level has been an on-going issue, as youth age out of recreational sports or decide to participate in more competitive private programs. The difference between Recreational sports programs and competitive programs, is that recreational programs are operated by a public entity and its primary goal is not to win games but to give the youth an enjoyable opportunity to participate and develop strong social bonds with people in their community. Recreational programs enhance self-esteem, self-confidence and a feeling of community and acceptance for all. Recreation sport programs for youth range from ages 6 & under to 13 & under. However, the help from great adult leaders and mentors in our community make these programs possible for the youth in our community. Those who are interested in being a mentor or coach in any of the Recreational Programs offered in the Town of Green Level should reach out to the Park and Recreation Specialist Jaimee Cousin.
